

UNIFORM POLICY

The school uniform aims to help learners develop modesty in the manner in which they dress. It seeks to aid them in appreciating the rationale behind the Islamic dress code. Learners are advised to dress modestly in school and out of school. Please look at the dress code below:



- Plain black Jilbab
- Jilbab/Burqa must be loose fit
- Plain black head scarf (rectangular) which covers both the chest and back
- Black trousers
- No jeans
- No leggings
- No make up
- No jewellery
- No nail polish
- Black shoes (no heels)
- Black socks

Parents must purchase two sets of uniform from school

PE KIT

- Black Shalwar (trouser style)
- Black Kameez down to the knees
- Black plimsolls/pumps
- Black socks
- Black head scarf (square or rectangular)

The school does not supply PE kits

If your child is unable to wear the correct school uniform for a valid reason, please call in and inform the school before 8:15 am

Learners who fail to wear the correct uniform without a reasonable excuse will either be sent home to bring the appropriate uniform or parents will be contacted to bring the correct uniform into school.

Learners who still fail to have their uniform will receive an hour detention after school.

Learners must follow the school's guidance on the following items:

School Bag

Learners must only use our school bags. Bags to be purchased from school at £18.

Coat

Pupils may only wear plain black coats that are loose fit. Leather jackets are not allowed.

Cardigan

Cardigans must be of plain black colour and are to be worn underneath the scarf
